JENNER GROUP – COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) SECONDWAVE POLICY

During our companywide temporary closure in response to the initial outbreak of the Coronavirus pandemic, the COVID-19 taskforce established at Jenner Group worked to ensure that all company policies and procedures were adapted accordingly to accommodate all new ways of working, our enhanced safety culture and heightened hygiene and cleanliness measures and to include social distancing guidelines.

In advance of implementation of a further period of national or localised lock-down, caused by a potential 'second-wave' of the coronavirus pandemic, it is the intention of the business, in our identified role as keyworkers and due to the importance of our work to society and the economy, to remain fully operational at this time. We will continue to conduct our sites under our enhanced safety guidelines unless clear directive to the construction industry to cease activity is issued from central government, and subject to availability of all essential material supplies and our subcontracted workforce to ensure sites can continue to progress.

Following the implementation of all new protocol and the time our previous closure allowed us to acclimatise to working in a socially distanced manner, we feel confident that we are now best-placed and fully prepared to work in a safe and responsible manner, continuously adapting to all evolving legislation and guidance from the government, the Construction Leadership Council (CLC) and our own professional safety advisors to ensure the safety of all those who work for and on behalf of Jenner, including those throughout our wider supply chain.

The situation continues to be monitored very closely on a day-by-day basis to ensure we remain efficient and effective in our guidance and instruction to safeguard all those within our duty of care, responding appropriately to the current risks and as the situation develops and with a zero-tolerance approach to non-conformance firmly in place. Each site will be individually monitored and adapt according to any more localised lockdown procedures, should these extend to the construction sector.

At this time it remains imperative that everyone stays alert and vigilant, with high regard for their colleagues, and follows the correct steps should they feel unwell or display the common symptoms of COVID-19 (high temperature and/or a new and continuous dry cough) Remote working continues to be encouraged alongside self-isolation and shielding for those who are vulnerable or at higher-risk and all staff have been issued with protective face coverings.
